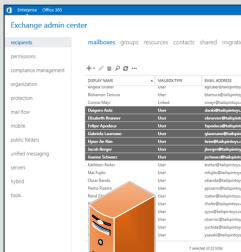

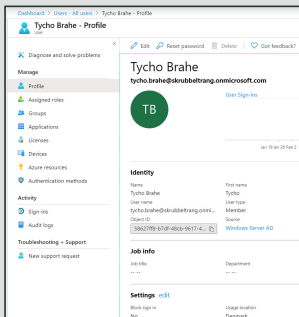
Active Directory Users & Computers

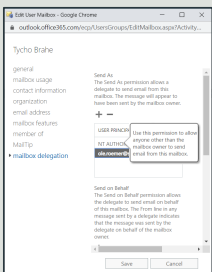

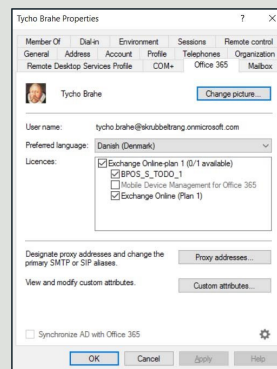

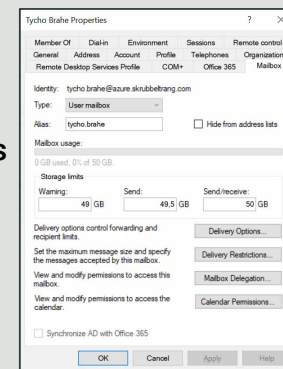

The Challenges

- Management of Hybrid Office 365 is confusing due to split attribute authority.
- Administration requires many tools (ADUC, multiple web consoles, PowerShell, Azure AD Connect).
- Exchange on-premises is needed to manage AD mail attributes.
- New admins need extensive training to manage Hybrid Office 365.

The Solution

- Easy365Manager extends AD Users & Computers with Office 365 license and mailbox management.
- All daily operations are performed in a single, well-known interface (ADUC).
- Exchange on-premises can be removed.
- Easy365Manager requires close to no training as it builds on a familiar interface.

Direct Savings

- Eliminates Exchange on-premises hardware/VM and associated power consumption.
- Eliminates Exchange on-premises patch management, monitoring and troubleshooting.
- Eliminates the license cost for the Exchange on-premises operating system.
- Eliminates 3rd party license costs for Exchange on-premises antivirus, monitoring, and backup software.

Indirect Savings

- No need to log in to multiple web consoles several times every day.
- No need for PowerShell to synchronize Azure AD Connect, configure calendar permissions, etc.
- Very easy to learn and understand for junior admins (reduced training costs).
- Eliminates the risk of zero-day exploits that target Exchange on-premises (like Hafnium).
